

Families and Friends,



LION KING TRIP TO NYC



Usually the show ends with the last performance. However, this year Harmony Theater is planning a trip to the Big Apple (Yes, New York City!) to see the Lion King at the Minskoff Theater on October 14, 2017. This Tony Award-winning musical has received rave reviews and its costumes, makeup and scenery are visually stunning.

The Hagey Tours charter bus will depart from the Montgomery Mall parking lot #34 (lower level near Sears Auto Center) at 10AM. The cost is \$160 per person for the show and the transportation. Actors must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Breakfast and/or lunch may be brought on the bus, but please no glass bottles. We will have dinner on the way home at a diner after we leave NYC (pay for your own). Please be advised that tickets are non-refundable, so if you miss the bus or you are sick that day, your money cannot be refunded.


